1. The following information, not disseminated, was reported initially to Gordon R. HAWLEY by AMING-3 on 5 February 1964 following his return from a month's visit to Santo Domingo and Puerto Rico. AMING-3 reported that he spent approximately 15 hours with AMBIDDY-1 and AMING-1 in the apartment of a friend in San Juan. The meetings occurred during the last week of January, while HAWLEY found that AMING-3 is normally quite reliable and objective on general political reporting, his own participation in anti-Castro political and political ambitions could conceivably influence his
