11. BECKOFF stressed that we were anxious not to give AMBIDDY-1 the impression that there exists any special relationship between us and AMJVA/4, AMJAVA/6. Our relationship was with AMBIDDY-1 who is the leader of the movement. AMJVA/4 replied that he had told AMBIDDY-1 this and that BECKOFF had made this point very clear at their first meeting in Puerto Rico (see AMBIDDY Meeting Memo, 5 September 1963 Subject Briefing of AMJAVA/4.) BECKOFF added that he had told AMJAVA/4 and wished to repeat this in the presence of AMJAVA/4 that anything discussed while AMBIDDY-1 was not present, could be told him. Nothing was "off-the-record" in the sense of to be withheld from AMBIDDY-1.

12. According to AMJAVA/4, AMBIDDY-1 knows full well that KUBARK considers him the Chief. If we decided to conspire against AMBIDDY-1 in league with AMJAVA/4 and AMTOP-19, this could only be done within AMTOP, the political movement, since AMJAVA/4 and AMTOP-19 form parts of that organization. Our support, however, is to AMBIDDY-1 and not AMTOP. AMBIDDY-1 knows that.
