4. Subject is aware that the story of his "immigration" to the USA is also weak. He tried to explain this away by stating that he "got out by mistake," that he was permitted to go "to hide the Soviet error surrounding the Cuban crisis," that "someone had committed an error," etc. He admitted that there exists no other explanation as to why the Soviet government would have permitted him to leave the USSR as, in the eyes of the Soviet government, he was a full-fledged and responsible Soviet citizen who had no grounds or legitimate claim to American citizenship. As a result, Subject is unusually sensitive to this topic.

c. It should be understood that because of the unique and sensitive cover used by the undersigned, no attempt was made to resolve the various contradictions, to challenge Subject on any of his statements, or to pursue certain points of their logical conclusions. The foregoing was obtained in the form of an interview and no real attempt could be made, given the cover, to delve more deeply into the suspicious aspects of Subject's background.
