4. A-1 gleefully reported he contemplates making quite a lot of changes in Miami. A-1 did not elaborate but it appears that most of the propaganda section will be leaving Miami.

5. A-1 was requested to obtain a position report of the DOLORES by 1 June.

1. AMBIDDY-1 called the office again to say that he would be meeting Al Burt at 1600. A-1 inquired if it would do any harm in seeing Mr. Sum of the State Department since the latter mentioned to AMJA-VA-4 that he had not seen A-1 in over a year. A-1 felt that a courtesy visit was called for. We advised A-1 that we could see no harm in visiting him.

2. A-1 reported that one of his pilots, Gimbern, had received an offer to fly planes in the Congo. A-1 did not know if Gimbern would accept the offer.

3. We told A-1 that we had received a report that in a finca in Nicaragua called Maranita he had met
